The teachers had some fabulous meals again at conference time. Thanks to **Julie Wanta** and the teacher hospitality committee for all the food preparation, set up and clean up.

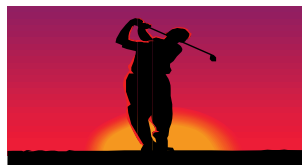
H&S Annual Golf Outing Scheduled
