**Coffee Selections:**

**Peru Light Roast (New)** (whole bean \_\_\_\_\_ ground \_\_\_\_\_ x \$10 = \_\_\_\_\_)

This coffee is bright with a hint of citrus. An excellent Peruvian coffee grown by the farmers of the Pangoa Cooperative in San Martin de Pangoa, Peru.

**Guatemalan Medium Roast** (whole bean \_\_\_\_\_ ground \_\_\_\_\_ x \$10 = \_\_\_\_\_)

Slightly nutty flavor and very smooth. This coffee is grown by the 31 families of the Santa Anita grower cooperative in Colomba Costa Cuca in the Pacific Coast highlands of the Sierra Madre. This was once a coffee estate that has since been converted to a cooperative.

**Nicaraguan Medium Roast** (whole bean \_\_\_\_\_ ground \_\_\_\_\_ x \$10 = \_\_\_\_\_)

Rich, with overtones of cocoa. This coffee is grown and exported by the women of La FEM cooperative. The women of La FEM derive their primary income from the sale of coffee and see fair trade as a path to economic prosperity.

**Dominican Republic French** (whole bean \_\_\_\_\_ ground \_\_\_\_\_ x \$10 = \_\_\_\_\_)

Bold, and full bodied with hints of chocolate. From the growers of FEDCARES cooperative. This coffee has the smallest carbon footprint, since it travels the shortest distance from country of origin to us.

**Bolivian Dark Roast** (whole bean \_\_\_\_\_ ground \_\_\_\_\_ x \$10 = \_\_\_\_\_)

Bright and well balanced with hints of smokiness. This coffee comes from the AIPEP grower coop in Pumiri, Bolivia. Each year they recruit fellow farmers and continue to grow.

**Half Caff\*** (whole bean \_\_\_\_\_ ground \_\_\_\_\_ x \$10 = \_\_\_\_\_)

All the flavor, half the caffeine. This coffee is a 50/50 blend of our French Roast Dominican Republic and our great-tasting decaf.

Great tasting water-processed decaf. A lighter roast for folks looking for a decaf coffee with the brightness and flavor common to lighter roasted coffee.

Great tasting, dark roasted water-processed decaf coffee.

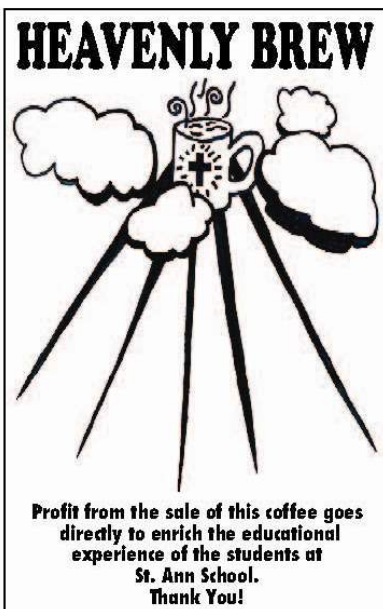

All Just Coffee products are shade grown and certified organic. Just Coffee's Heavenly Brew comes in 12 ounce bags at \$10 per bag. Flavor descriptions on the back of this order form are for the coffees themselves; nothing is added to the beans but the heat necessary to roast them.

While the Just Coffee fundraiser is designed to earn money for our school, it also supports families and coffee-growing communities around the globe by bolstering their economies. Fair trade represents the efforts of people who want to create a better system of exchange. Just Coffee products come from democratically controlled grower cooperatives, not single-owner estates, and these small-scale farmers are paid an equitable price for their crop.
