Principal's Corner

You Can't Have It Both Ways

Growing up in a household of six kids, I often heard my mom say, “ You can't have it both ways.” This phrase came out of mom's mouth when one of us tried to benefit from a situation no matter what the circumstance. In this upcoming Sunday's Gospel, Jesus says that his disciples can't have it both ways; we can't serve two masters.

In the Gospel reading from Luke, Jesus tells of a man who is accused of squandering his employer's resources and so is about to lose his job. To plan for his unemployment, the man goes to people who owe money to his employer and he reduces their debts. He figures that these people will have to help him out when he loses his job. This man is not concerned about the needs of others but only his own. Everything he does serves his own purposes and needs. He cheats his employer and arranges for others to cheat also for his own benefit.

We really don't think of ourselves as having “masters' in our culture today. But we do use our time and money to serve our own interests. Sports, friends, belongings, clothes, jobs or hobbies , might be thought of as masters in our lives. Jesus says that we cannot serve two masters, that our hearts cannot be completely faithful to God while we take care of our own selfish concerns. We will love God, which motivates us to serve others out of love for God, or we tend to look at things selfishly, thinking, “It's all about me.”

Know of my prayers for you as you serve God through loving and caring for others. May your hearts be filled with faith and joy as you choose God over the other “masters” of your life.

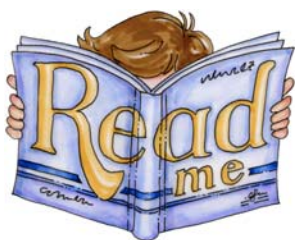
Did you forget to pay your September Tuition Payment? September Monthly Tuition was due on Monday, September 16. Prompt payments are greatly appreciated.

Support our School!

WHAT IS SCRIP?

Scrip is a program used by St. Ann Home & School to raise funds to assist St. Ann School & Church with expenses, such as school field trips, building improvements, updating curriculum, purchasing new technology, etc.

HOW DOES SCRIP WORK?

Scrip comes in the form of gift cards – just like gift cards you would get from individual retailers. What’s the difference? With St. Ann’s Scrip, the gift cards are available for purchase at face value through St. Ann Home & School. Scrip cards are purchased by Home & School from Great Lakes Scrip Center (GLSC) at a discounted price. The discounted amount is deposited into the St. Ann’s Home & School Scrip account as a profit.

EXAMPLE:

You go to Pick N Save to purchase \$100 worth of groceries. You could spend that \$100 directly from your bank account or purchase a gift card to use from Pick N Save to buy your groceries. \$100 spent is \$100 spent. However, if you purchase a Pick N Save Scrip card for \$100, you would pay St. Ann’s Scrip that \$100 and get a gift card worth \$100. Because GLSC sells the Scrip cards to St. Ann’s at a discounted price, Home & School would make a 4% profit (\$4) from the card you purchased. That might not seem like much profit, but with the families who participated last year in the Scrip Program, St. Ann’s made well over \$4,000 to assist St. Ann’s School & Church with expenses.

HOW IS SCRIP ORDERED?

There are two options for ordering Scrip.

OPTION 1: Fill out an order form and leave it in the school office. The Scrip Committee will process your order for you. Scrip order forms are available in the school office or on the bulletin board outside the staff lounge.

OPTION 2: Set up an online account. To set up an online account, follow these steps:

Go to www.shopwithscrip.com.

Click on the “Create Account” icon.

Fill in all information required (some spaces are optional).

Click on and read the terms at the bottom of the page. Click “agree” to the terms to continue.

Choose security questions, type answers and save.

Enter St. Ann’s Home & School Enrollment Code 8DA9F4356219.

Place your order.

If your order is more than \$50, please drop off your payment in the school office after placing your online order. **If your order is less than \$50**, you may pay for your order when you pick up your cards.
