## The Month of the Rosary

Traditionally, the month of October has been celebrated as one of the months when we honor Mary in a special way. One of the special ways to honor Mary during this month is by praying the rosary. October 7 is celebrated as the Memorial of Our Lady of the Rosary.

As a child, my First Communion rosary was one of my prized possessions that was used often as my family gathered in prayer. During the month of October, my family gathered each night after supper to pray the rosary. Each one of the six kids would lead the beginning prayers or a decade, and mom and dad would read the scripture passage which corresponded to the mystery celebrated. It was our family's version of the Living Rosary, a very special Leonard family tradition. Often during a storm or when we were traveling, the saying of the rosary was initiated. Even today, as I look around my mom's house, I see a rosary in every room on an end table, on a door knob, on the kitchen table or underneath her pillow, so that my mom throughout her day can say a rosary or two or three or...for special people and events that are happening in the lives of her children and grandchildren.

Over the years, by meditating on the mysteries of the rosary, my love and understanding of scripture was and continues to be deepened. I truly have experienced the presence of God as my prayer has centered on the events of Christ's life. As Mother Teresa of Calcutta has shared, "In praying the rosary with devotion, we are reliving the life of Christ."

Know of my prayers for you as you consider beginning the family tradition of praying the rosary together during the month of October. The students and families of St. Ann School will be in my prayers as I pray a rosary daily.
