Jesus' Message of Love

Before I head across the street to school each morning I read and reflect upon the daily scripture readings. Since the Feast of Christmas, we see daily revealed to us through the Gospel readings, an adult and public Jesus. All of a sudden Jesus is a man and has embarked on his public ministry, that of preaching, healing and teaching. We will follow the public life of Jesus from now until and through the season of Lent to the end of Jesus' public life at the time of his crucifixion, death and resurrection.

What was it about Jesus that made others sit up and take notice? He must have expressed himself with great confidence and his personality must have been one that attracted notice because it radiated happiness and holiness.
