## A Man Born Blind

I have been wearing glasses since fourth grade. My mom observed that I was squinting, sitting too close to the television and holding books too close to my eyes. My teacher noticed the same things plus I would get up out of my seat and move closer to the blackboard when assignments were written on the board. So for the past 51 years, I have worn glasses or contacts and have now graduated to the dreaded progressive bifocals. With these simple eye aids, I can see perfectly and enjoy all that is a part of my busy days.

As I read today's Gospel reading from Mark, we see Jesus giving sight to a man who had been blind all his life. All of his life, he walked with those who had sight. In fact some of his friends brought him to Jesus, begging Jesus to touch him. Jesus put spittle on the man's eyes, asking him if he could see clearly. His vision was blurry at first, but then Jesus touched his eyes a second time and his vision became clearer and clearer.

The healing touch of Jesus changed the man's life. The man was not only physically given sight, but spiritually, light was brought to the dark spots of his life as he experienced the goodness of God and the beauty of the world and the people around him.

As we prepare to begin our Lenten journey on Wednesday, March 5, I pray that your words and actions help others to see and feel the healing touch and unending love of Jesus. May you gain new sight to see God's presence and beauty in your everyday activities this Lenten season.
